and 2,700 square
yards of asphalt later,
the job is done! The
contractor, a Christian
with a stellar reputation
in repaying work, was highly

motivated to do his best work for a Christ-centered ministry. It is highway-quality work, engineered to accommodate the weight of large coach buses and recreation applications for years to come.

After Alpine's own crew spent weeks preparing by digging trenches to run conduit for electrical needs and pouring footings for new basketball goals, A & Y Company came in and repaved the entire area May 28-June 2.

This is a big deal! Alpine needed to upgrade this very visible first impression to provide a more hospitable and safe welcome. The cracks and

potholes had become a safety issue, and therefore it was no longer a good recreation space. Alpine had developed a reputation as an old, run-down camp

with some groups and was losing business. As we have strategically repaired and painted buildings, quests and neighbors are commenting on the refreshed look. It is crucial we provide intact grounds and facilities for each group to achieve their goals without the distraction of safety concerns or unsightly areas. The basketball court



phrase is simply, "Alpine exists to help churches with the discipleship and spiritual formation of their children."

This is what Alpine's founders had in mind. And this phrase resonates deeply with people because, as the Holy Spirit reveals Truth, those who hear this phrase recognize in it the teaching of Deuteronomy 6:1-9, especially verse 7: "Impress them (God's commandments) on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home, when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up."



That verse is an apt description of what happens at Alpine: walking out this verse, side by side with campers hour by hour, day by day.



It is challenging to do verse seven well at home because of the pace of life and the number of distractions. However, at Alpine the distractions are minimized, the pace changes, and the opportunities increase for talking about God's Word and why it matters. Not only is God's Word taught and discussed, it is experienced. If a teaching time in chapel is the "lecture," living together in a few cabins on 46 acres of forest for a weekend or a week is the "lab." Campers test these teachings in this microcosm of life together.

The results of this "lecture/lab" combination is a real life encounter with Truth and Grace along with concrete, practical experience in loving God with all of one's heart, soul, mind and strength; and loving one's neighbor as one's self. May God bless what He brings about.
